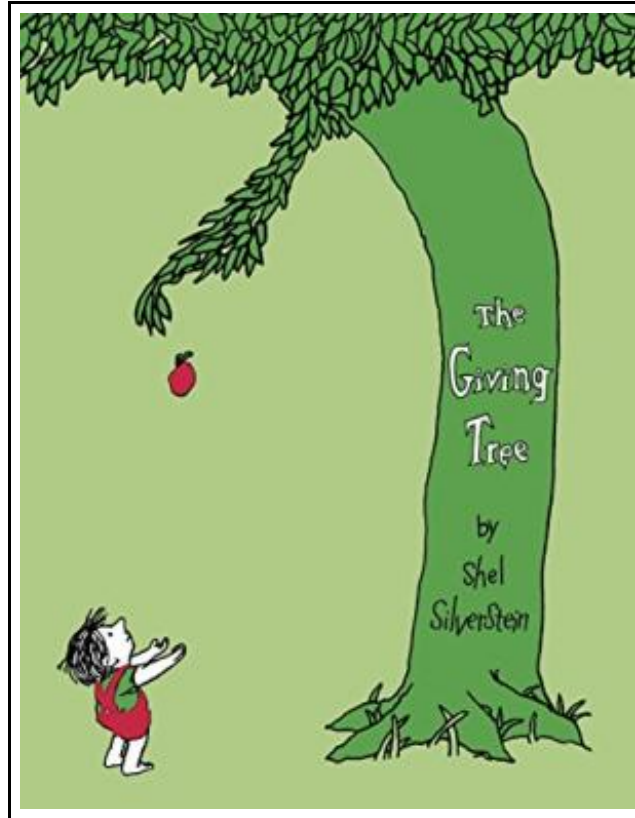

His first collection of poems and drawings, Where the Sidewalk Ends , appeared in 1974, and his second, A Light in the Attic , in 1981. When he was a G.I. in Japan and Korea in the 1950, he learned to play the guitar and to write songs, including A Boy Named Sue for Johnny Cash. In 1984, Silverstein won a Grammy Award for Best Children s Album...
