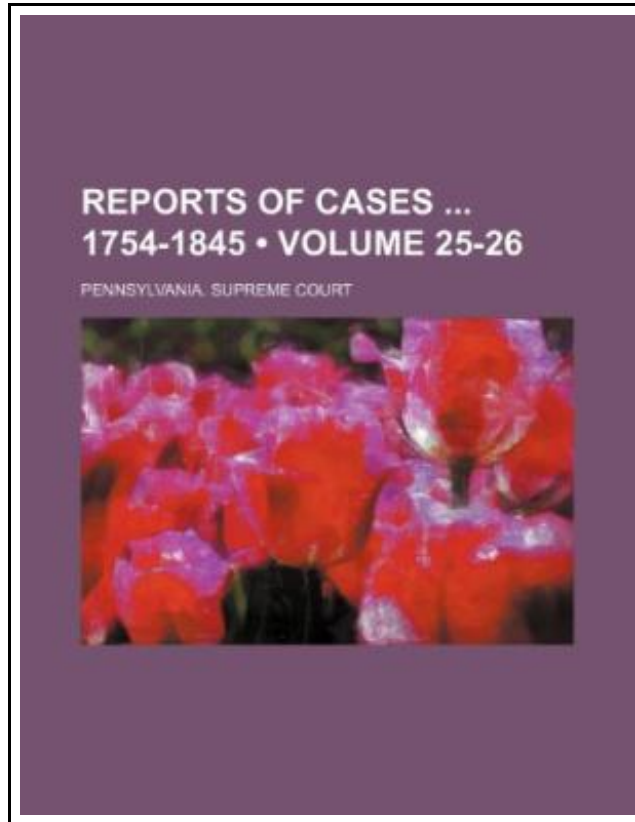

By these articles, Burke agreed, in consideration of the sum of 5500, 3500 of which were to be paid on the 1st of April next ensuing the date of the articles, and the residue in one year from that day, to convey to Huber, on the 1st of April 1817, a good title to ten acres of land, situate in the town of Millersburg, in Manor township, Lancaster county, on which a tavern and other buildings were erected, together with the stove in the bar-room; the premises subject to the yearly ground-rent of five shillings per acre. Burke reserved to himself the possession of the premises, until the day on which the deed was to be executed, when he covenanted to deliver peaceable possession to Huber. For the faithful performance of the covenants contained in the articles, the parties bound themselves in the penalty of 11, 000.
